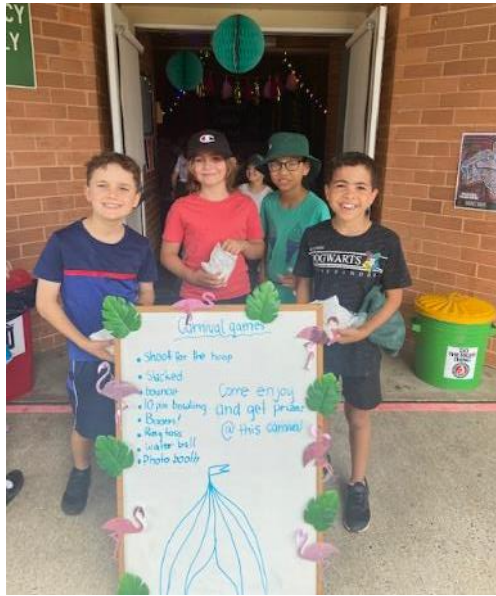

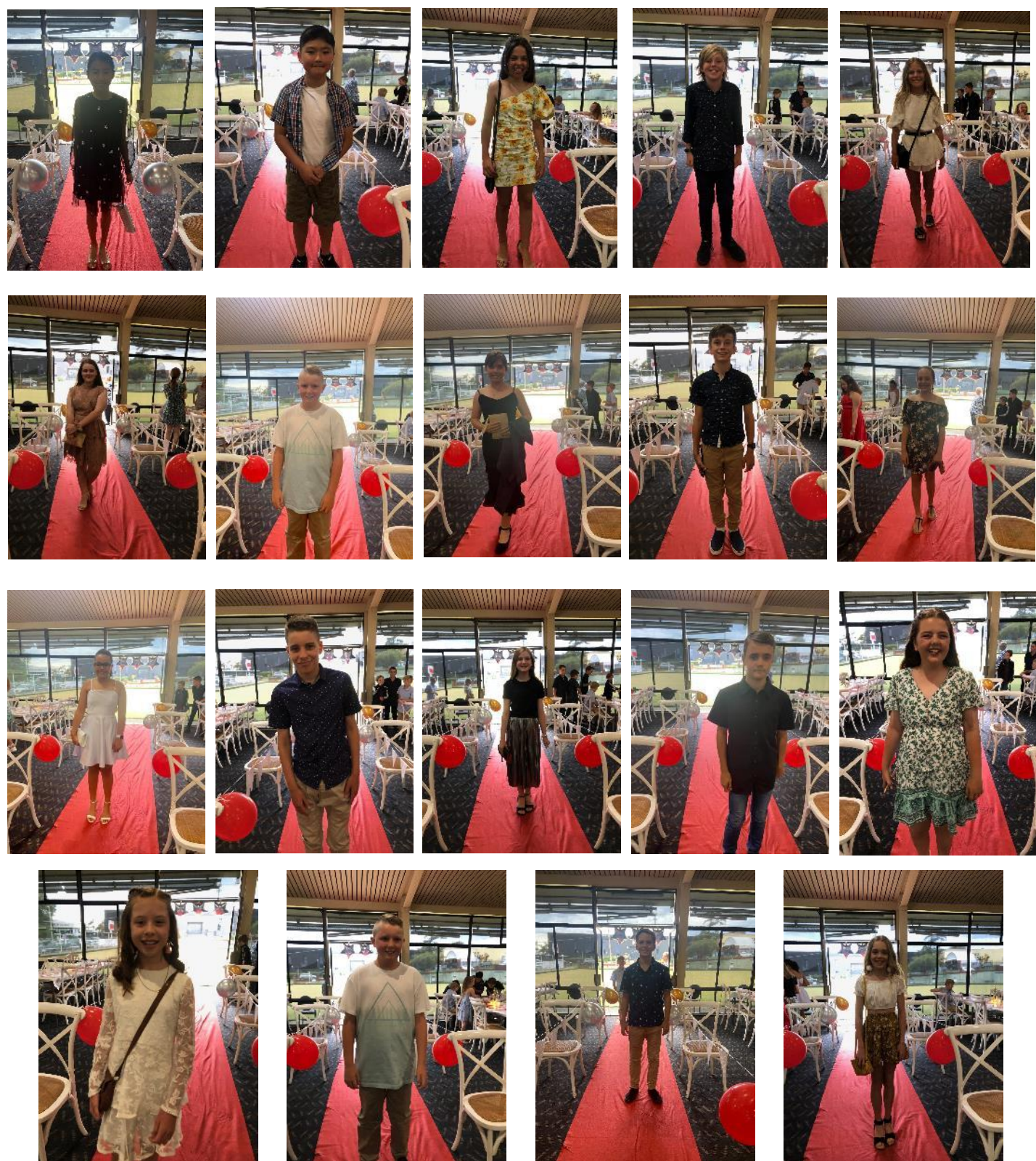

You will always have a special place in my heart.

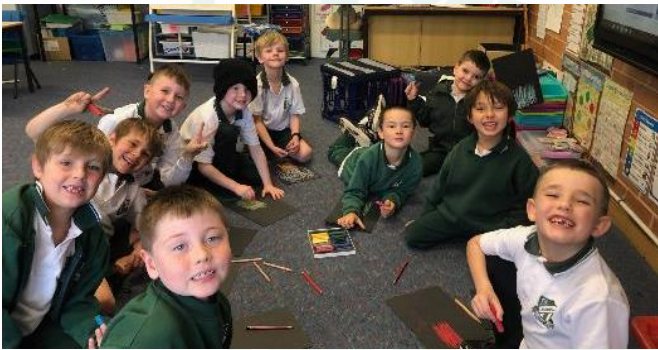

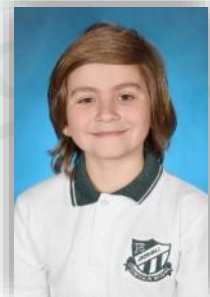

What an outstanding year we've had in 4/5W! Even with the roller-coaster of 2020 we managed to make every minute of learning count.

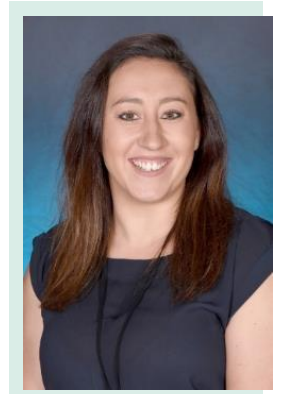

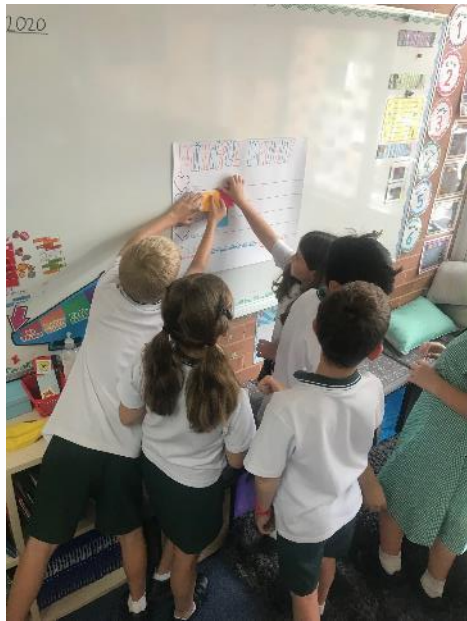

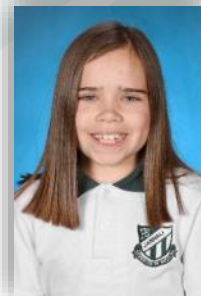
